# HC to cops: What steps taken to enforce ban on Chinese manjha?

**New Delhi:** The Delhi high court on Thursday asked Delhi Police to inform it of the steps taken to implement the National Green Tribunal's (NGT) order banning sale of Chinese manjha, which is used for kite flying.

The court was hearing a public interest litigation (PIL) seeking a complete ban on flying, sale, purchase, storage, and transportation of the glass-coated strings that kill and injure many people and birds annually.

"What steps Delhi Police has taken to ensure that Chinese 'manjha' is not used? What steps have you taken for implementation of the NGT order? Take instructions and inform us," a bench of Chief Justice Satish Chandra Sharma and Justice Subramonium Prasad said.

Delhi government's standing counsel (criminal) Sanjay Lao stated that orders in this regard are passed every year and sought time to

take instructions. The court then posted the matter for Friday.

On its part, the Centre's standing counsel, Anil Soni, stated that the NGT has already passed directions in this regard and the problem is not with kites, but with the Chinese synthetic manjha. The PIL said that "every kite flyer tries to source and use string/thread that is glass coated or metallic, popularly known as Chinese manjha, which is more dangerous and lives and safety of not only humans but also of birds are endangered due to this."

Petitioner Sanser Pal Singh claimed that a complete ban on the dangerous manjha, its making, sale and purchase, and storage is the only solution as it is difficult to catch the culprit or fix the responsibility in case of an accident. Singh further said that he met with an accident in 2006 when a kite string got entangled around his body and in an attempt to save the neck, he sustained injuries in his finger.

## DCW issues notices to DMs on acid sale

**New Delhi:** Delhi Commission for Women (DCW) has issued notices to all district magistrates of the capital seeking information on the penalty imposed on acid sale in the city.

DCW said unregulated acid sale is a major cause for continued acid attacks against women and girls and the commission has many times recommended a complete ban on retail sale of acid. However, the same has not been imposed and acid is continuously being sold openly in the capital, said DCW.

The Supreme Court has given several directions to the Union and state governments to regulate the sale of acid to prevent acid attacks in India. In this regard, the Delhi government had passed an order for regulating the sale of acid, which empowers the SDM to impose a penalty of up to Rs 50,000 for violations.

DCW chairperson Swati Maliwal said, "Acid attack is a heinous crime. A complete ban on retail sale of acid is the need of the hour. The commission is trying to fix the accountability of the district administration vis-a-vis unregulated sale of acid in Delhi. Also, the penalty amount collected by SDMs for violation of orders related to regulation of acid sale should be used for the rehabilitation of acid attack survivors. The commission is trying to ascertain whether the same is being done or not."

# Pistols, live cartridges seized two weeks before I-Day

**New Delhi:** Two weeks before Independence Day, cops have recovered a dozen sophisticated pistols and live cartridges from a trafficker at the Delhi-Faridabad border. The suspect was supplying firearms in Delhi-NCR, Punjab, Haryana and western Uttar Pradesh for the past three years, police said.

The accused was identified as Dhruv from Dholpur, Rajasthan. DCP Jasmeet Singh said the accused was previously involved in four cases of dacoity at gunpoint and a case of arms trafficking.

Dhruv used to get arms and ammunition supplied from manufacturers in Khargone in Madhya Pradesh, a probe has revealed. Till now, the suspect has allegedly trafficked over 400 weapons.

"The suspect has been booked under the amended Arms Act in which there is a provision of a minimum sentence of 10 years, which can be extended up to life imprisonment," the DCP added.

Cops nabbed the suspect as a part of their drive against the illegal firearms traffickers in Delhi-NCR who were involved in procuring firearms from Sendwara, Khargone, Dhar and Burhanpur areas of MP. He

was arrested from near Aali village with the weapons when he arrived to deliver them to his contact.

During interrogation, the accused revealed that he earlier used to work as a carrier for a notorious arms trafficker of Rajasthan. However, he soon started operating individually. "Dhruv procured a semi-automatic pistol for Rs 10,000 and a single-shot pistol for Rs 3,000 and sold them to criminals for Rs 25,000 and 6,000 each, respectively. Recently, he had delivered a consignment to a gangster in Punjab," cops claimed.

Efforts to arrest the remaining members of the arms syndicate are being made, police said.
