IN RVNL, INDIA GETS ITS 13TH NAVRATNA

Rail Vikas Nigam (RVNL) became the 13th central public sector enterprise (CPSE) to get the Navratna status. It was in 2014 when Engineers India was last conferred with Navratna status.

For a CPSE to be eligible for Navratna status, the company must have Miniratna I status, a schedule A status, and should have obtained 'excellent' or 'very good' memorandum of understanding rating in three of the last five years.

The company must get a score of 60 of 100 in parameters like net profit, cost of production, service cost, capital employed, earnings per share, and inter sectoral performance.
