



■ IOC, BPCL, HPCL, GAIL Told to Ready Green Hydrogen Plan by Month End

NEW DELHI The government has asked Indian Oil Corporation, BPCL, HPCL and GAIL to present a detailed plan by the end of the month on how they intend to produce, procure and consume green hydrogen, said sources. The government is putting together a large plan to adopt green hydrogen as part of the energy transition and expects oil and fertiliser companies to lead it. Refineries have been the biggest user of hydrogen, although all of it is currently produced using fossil fuel. —**Sanjeev Choudhary**
