Application received after 23rd August, 2019 will not be entertained.

Consultants applying against the EOI will be screened based on the technical proposals submitted by them in the attached template along with supporting documents. Shortlisted consultants will only be eligible to participate in the subsequent tendering process for engagement of consultant(s) for the project.

Brief Scope of work, Terms of reference/engagement is indicated in the following sections. Detailed Scope of Work, Schedule of Rates, Evaluation Methodology, Bid Evaluation Criteria etc. will be intimated during the subsequent tendering process.

1.0 Back Ground:

- 1.1 GAIL is the one of the Maharatna PSUs engaged in the business of Natural gas transmission, distribution and marketing, Gas processing for LPG Production, Production of petrochemicals and transmission of LPG in the country and has also diversified into Exploration and Telecom business as well. GAIL's JVs operate one of India's largest gas based power generation facility (RGPPL), LNG regasification terminals at Dabhol, Dahej & Kochi as well as gas distribution businesses including Indraprastha Gas Ltd. Delhi and Mahanagar Gas Limited in Mumbai & GAIL Gas Ltd. GAIL holds participating interest in 28 E&P blocks in India, 2 E&P blocks in Myanmar and in South East Asia Gas Pipeline Company. GAIL Global (USA) Inc. (GGUI), a subsidiary, focuses on US operations which have acquired shale assets in Texas. Another subsidiary GAIL Global (Singapore) Pte Ltd. undertakes trading activities in Singapore.
- 1.2 At present GAIL are having LPG / Gas Processing Plants at Vijaipur, Vaghodia, Usar, Gandhar and Petrochemical complex at Pata (U.P) apart from operating Natural gas pipelines (HBJ and Non-HBJ), LPG Pipelines from Vizag to Secunderabad (VSPL) & Jamnagar to Loni (JLPL) also having network of Zonal Marketing offices at Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Bhopal, Chandigarh, Chennai, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai, & Noida.
- 1.3 Quality Circles projects are being in approx. 40 (Forty) work centres of GAIL including Plant, Compressor Stations, Terminals, Zonal offices etc.
- 1.4 The contract shall be executed by single party only.

2.0 Scope of Work:

- 2.1 The bidder is to conduct awareness training / counselling sessions on Quality Circle / Lean Quality Circle / 5 S / Kizen / Six Sigma etc. for two years at various GAIL installations across the country. The number of days against awareness training / counselling sessions conducted at various sites shall be counted as Number of Mandays.
- 2.2 The deputed faculty members / consultant for this particular job must be trained in latest Quality Circle tools & techniques, concepts / Advance TQM tools by reputed institutions. The bidder should have at least five (5) numbers of such key faculty members / lead faculty members/ Consultant.
- 2.3 The Bidder shall submit a declaration on actual deployment of said personnel and also submit the profile / Biodata key faculty members / lead faculty members/ Consultant.
- 2.4 Employees of work centres of GAIL including Plant, Compressor Stations, Terminals, Zonal offices are to be covered in QC program during the contract period.
- 2.5 Learning materials related to classroom training/ workshops / Inter unit level conventions are to be provided to the participant by the consultant whenever such program is conducted. No amount shall be paid to contractor against learning/ study material, book, work book etc. distributed to the participants.

- a) The bidder should designate a **Coordinator** for this contract who will be solely responsible for coordinating with GAIL regarding:
 - i) Scheduling of awareness cum counselling sessions.
 - ii) Making action plans for achieving MOU target.
 - iii) Submitting monthly report.
 - iv) Preparing management presentations.
 - v) Project report of CMD Trophy award winner QC Projects and qualified QC Projects.
 - vi) Coordinating with various faculty members for obtaining project status reports and for ensuring travel material dispatch or other administrative arrangements whenever QC awareness training / counselling /management review programmers are organized at various work centres of GAIL. GAIL will coordinate with the same Project Coordinator till the entire execution of the contract
- 2.6 Projects like 5S, Kaizen TPM etc. will be taken up by the Quality Circles and the improvement action plans identified by QC's would be implemented with the approval of management. The consultant will be required to coach / train the QC team members / leaders/ Coordinators in the basics of QC Concepts, philosophy, TQM tools and techniques. The Consultant should be able to facilitate the team members /leaders & Champions for applying the QC Tools & techniques in daily work life to improve the value of goods and services at the workplace. The process of facilitation may also include among other things, providing data for analysis in some cases recommended solutions for some problems.
- 2.7 The consultant will arrange & bear the all charges for boarding & lodging and any incidental expenses during the visit. GAIL Guest House may be provided to the consultant on chargeable basis (as per company rule) subject to availability.
- 2.8 All expenses including local conveyances, travelling expenses (by Road / Train / Air), and foods during travelling charges will be borne by the consultant.
- 2.9 Any transportation work connected with contract or otherwise is under the bidder's scope and no separate rates are admissible on this account. Boarding and lodging facilities for bidder's personal for carrying out the work is to be made by the bidder at his own cost.

4.0 Evaluation of Technical Criteria (Quality Based):

The qualitative evaluation of the Consultant will be based on the Consultant's relevant experience, methodology and key personnel. The Quality shall be evaluated based on the technical score against each parameter are given in the table below:

Note: The minimum qualifying Technical Score for meeting Quality criterion shall be 75. The Financial Bids of those Consultants (Bidders) shall be opened who obtain more than or equal to 75 marks.

GAIL shall not give marks against a Technical parameter in the absence of requisite supporting documents. No further correspondence shall be made by GAIL in this regard.

5.0 Evaluation of Proposal Criteria (Quality and Cost Based Selection)

Evaluation of proposals will be carried out in two stages, first stage is the quality and 2nd stage is the cost. The qualitative evaluation of the bidder/consultant will be based on the bidder/consultant's relevant experience, methodology and key personnel. Each criterion shall be evaluated based on the marks. *The enlisted consultants / bidders shall be asked for financial proposal* and shall be evaluated for total combined technical (Quality) and financial (Cost) score as per given formula:

- A) Technical Evaluation:
 - St = Combined Technical Score obtained based on technical parameters.
- B) Evaluation of cost:

The proposal with the lowest cost (Fm) shall be given financial score (Sf) of 100 points. The financial score of other proposal shall be computed as follows:

S(f) = 100 X Fm/F

Where

Fm= Lowest bidding price obtained in the bidding process.

F= Amount of financial proposal of the bidder.

C) Combined Quality and Cost Evaluation:

The total score shall be obtained by weighing the combined quality/technical and cost scores and adding them as follows:

$$S = St \times Tw + Sf \times Fw$$

Where

S = Total score (combined score)

St = Technical score obtained based on technical competency/Parameters

Sf = Relative Financial score obtained based on quoted price (As per formula given above in B)

Tw = Weight assigned to technical score i.e. **70%** or 0.70

Fw = Weight assigned to financial score i.e. 30% or 0.30

6.0 Award of Contract:

The bidder/consultant scored the highest shall be awarded the contract.

The offers received shall be evaluated in two stages on QCBS basis with 70% weightage for quality and 30% for cost. Further the proposal shall be considered unsuitable and shall be rejected at the technical evaluation level (quality aspect) if it fails to achieve a minimum technical score of 75%.

In case more than one bidder/ consultant obtained same total combined technical and financial score, preference will be given to the bidder/ consultant who have successfully executed higher number of similar jobs as defined in parameter no 1 of technical evaluation criteria on the basis of documents submitted along with the EOI.

7.0 Time of Contract Period:

- 7.1 The entire work shall be completed strictly within the time schedule i.e. Two years from the date of LOA.
- 7.2 The decision of the "EIC" regarding extension of the contract, due to the delay attributable to the causes of force Majeure, extra work or due to the reasons attributable to the GAIL, shall be final and biding on the bidder.
- 7.3 If required, the contract may be extended for a further period of six months on the same rates, terms & conditions of the existing contract. The bidder shall be abiding by all the terms & conditions of the contract for the extended period.

8.0 Terms of Payment:

- 8.1 100 % of payment shall be released based on monthly running account bill (RA Bill) for the jobs completed based on executed Man Days as per the Schedule of Rate and scope of work.
- 8.2 Travel time of the consultants' from their office to GAIL work centres and back to their office will not be counted as Man days.

- 8.3 No travelling expenses shall be paid separately and expenses are included in man-days quoted rate.
- 8.4 The bills shall be submitted in 02 sets along with all supporting documents.
- 8.5 The bidder shall submit final bill (as full & final settlement) after completion of the entire scope of work
- 8.6 Final Bill along with No Claim/ No Dues Certificate and Indemnity Bond shall be submitted within 30 days of completion of contract period

Note: The Bidder is required to submit copy of Work Order/ Contract Agreement etc. and Completion/ Execution Certificate duly attested by Chartered Engineer & Public Notary.
